

Cherish All Children's mission is to educate, equip, and engage churches and communities to prevent child sexual exploitation and trafficking. Throughout the pandemic, there has been a *significant* increase in online exploitation. Cherish All Children's work is addressing this with youth, parents, and all concerned adults to provide young people with the skills to keep themselves safe online.

 In 2021, the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children's CyberTipline received 29.3 million reports of suspected child sexual exploitation, an increase of 35% from 2020.

Here's how Cherish All Children responded in 2021 to support churches in keeping children and youth safe in our communities:

- In January, we hosted a community event "Online Safety for Youth" via Zoom, inviting Mpls & St. Paul Synod churches and the general public.
- We created a 4-session <u>Safe & Healthy Relationships Youth Guide</u> for middle school and high school youth groups, with engaging activities, video and conversation to guide youth in making safe choices for themselves and their peers.
- We presented to church youth groups, adult forums, and Zoom worship throughout the year, focused especially on online safety and healthy relationships.
- 70 walkers/runners participated in a virtual Cherish All Children 5K in June, helping to raise \$22,000 for our work thank you for all the support and fun!

We have a dedicated St. Paul Area Synod Ministry Team reaching out to congregations to engage in this critical work, and we'd love to add Minneapolis Area Synod members to partner with us – reaching more youth and families to keep them safe.
